GOVERNMENTAL FUNDS FOOTNOTES (revised)

 A portion of personal income tax receipts is also transferred to the State Special Revenue School Tax Relief (STAR) Fund and used to reimburse school districts for the STAR property tax exemptions for homeowners. Local Assistance Education grant payments total \$186.7m for the month of September, \$609.0m for October and \$817.5m for November.

- 2. More than 60% of the proceeds from the State cigarette tax of \$1.50 (per pack) are deposited in the Tobacco Control and Insurance Initiatives Pool established in the Health Care Reform Act of 2000 (HCRA). General Fund Receipts do not include \$398.8m of cigarette tax receipts, which were collected by the State and transferred, off budget, to the Tobacco Control and Insurance Initiatives Pool.
