The Fiscal Stress Monitoring System and resulting fiscal stress designations rely on data (as of 2/27/2021) from annual financial reports submitted by local governments to the Office of the State Comptroller.

This list (sorted in order of fiscal stress score) includes all non-calendar fiscal year end municipalities.

April 2021 Release Note:

These fiscal stress scores are based on end-of-year results, and generally provide a measurement of local governments' ability to respond to the financial impact of the ongoing public health crisis.
