

Additional Information Regarding Unrecoverable Overpayments

If an overpayment is not recoverable and an automatic negative retroactive adjustment is generated, the automatic adjustment will be disabled (turned off). However, if the employee subsequently receives another retroactive change for the same period, another retroactive adjustment will be calculated automatically, but will be incorrect.

OSC will notify the Agency of the subsequent retroactive adjustment for the same period. The Agency will be responsible for determining the amount of the adjustment due to the employee, after taking into consideration the amount initially overpaid and not recovered.

If an adjustment is due to the employee, the Agency must provide OSC with the adjustment amount that will be processed and the calculation to be used.
